

ATSCO PHOTOVOLTAIC MODULE (S) WARRANTY CERTIFICATE

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ATSCO Güneş Panelleri İst. Soğ. Tic. Ltd. Şti. a manufacturing company of photovoltaic modules, warranties that its products fulfill all applicable quality specifications. ATSCO provides a product warranty and a performance warranty. The product warranty covers the material and workmanship of the module, whereas loss of performance (efficiency) and minimum output of the module are exclusively the object of the performance warranty.

The warranty starts with delivery date to the final customer. Customer need to demonstrate delivery date by handing in their original invoice or appropriate verification

A. Product Warranty

ATSCO provides a warranty to the final customer (consumer) under the conditions stated herein for a period of 2 years from the delivery date that;
“failures due to workmanship and manufacturing, defects and/or failures due to materials, cracking of the glass surface due to foreign objects inside the glass”

B. Performance Warranty

ATSCO warranties, for the periods stated below that during and up to the end of these periods, Power Output that is measured in standart test conditions will not be less than indicated values as below;

Limited warranties of percentage of delivered Power
10 Year limited warranty of %90 of Minimum Power Output
25 Year limited warranty of %80 of Minimum Power Output

The power output values shall be measured under the standard measurement conditions as follows: light spectrum of AM 1.5; irradiation of 1,000 w per m²; and a cell temperature of 25 °C. Such measurements are carried out in accordance with IEC 60904 standart requirement and the measuring device will be calibrated according to ATSCO calibration procedure when the module is produced. The power measurements will only be valid if carried out at ATSCO and not in external laboratories.

If at any time during the indicated validity periods of this guarantee, the Photovoltaic Module does not comply with the expressed power values, ATSCO agrees, depending on the fault that has arisen, to repair or to replace the faulty Module(s), or to supply the necessary additional modules until the loss of Power has been compensated, or to refund the amount received from the client when it purchased the faulty Modules or otherwise.

C. Warranty Conditions

1. Guaranties has been warrantied only to the final customer. Warranties are not binding for distributors and installation companies or second-hand purchasers of the modules. Final customers are all parties who has been purchased modules for their own needs or who have purchased a building on which the modules were first installed. The module must be a part of a solar system in which it was first operated. Guaranties of ATSCO shall not apply to modules which have been unfixed and reinstalled, except for the purposes of repair, or have been used for another purpose.
2. Damage and faults regarding to manufacturing or service of the Modules will be exempted from the warrantie conditions stated herein, caused by the following:
 - Fault to fulfill the manuals for installation, use, and maintenance set out in the corresponding ATSCO User Manuals.
 - Usage, installations, of revision that is not appropriate or carried out by authorized person or supplier.
3. Accidents caused by careless, inconvenient usage.
4. Damage or failures caused by lightning, floods, natural forces, acts of God or force majeure events and other unforeseen circumstances or earthquakes, typhoons, hurricanes, tornadoes, extraordinary weather conditions, volcanic action, floods, tsunami, lightning, snow damage causes beyond reasonable control including, but not limited to, , etc.;

5. No claim based on this limited warranty may be brought after the applicable warranty period. Any delivery of additional PV module(s) shall not extend the original terms of this limited warranty
6. Payments for disassembly, tests, disposal, transportation, installation and re-installation of the modules or individual components of these modules within the scope of this voluntary warranty are to be borne by the final customer.
7. The guarantee rights established herein do not cover the shipping costs of the defective Modules incurred by the return to ATSCO and their subsequent return to the client. It also does not include the intervention costs for disassembling the faulty Modules or the subsequent reinstallation of the replaced Modules within the scope of this voluntary warranty are to be borne by the final customer.
8. If these warranty conditions deviate from the specifications that stated in the datasheet, these warranty conditions will be valid.

D. Warranty Limitations of Liability

- i. ATSCO would not be liable to the customer, directly or indirectly, for any failure to fulfill or delay in complying its liabilities under warrantee that may conclude from force major or any other unexpected incident not intended by ATSCO unless such other warranties, obligations or liabilities are expressly agreed to in writing by ATSCO.
- ii. ATSCO shall have no responsibility or liability whatever for damages or injury to persons or property or for other injury resulting from any cause whatever arising out of or relating to the PV module(s) including, without limitation, any defects and/or failures in the PV module(s) or from use or installation.

E. Validity

This limited warranty shall be applicable from September 1st, 2011 and shall apply to all ATSCO branded Photovoltaic Modules, standart range manufactured from that date and this certificate will be valid until this document is revised which will be informed in writing with notification given.


F. How to Deal With Claims
